Oct.–Apr. 9:30 am to 4:30 pm
(Last admission is 30 min. before closing time)
- Closed / Every Monday, the last Tuesday of each month, the day after a public holiday, the day after the last day of a special exhibition, and from December 27th to January 4th.
*Open every day during special exhibition periods and from April 29th to May 5th.
- Admission fees / Please exchange Value Ticket coupons or joint-use tickets for admission tickets at the ticket sales booth.
Those of junior high school age and under are admitted free of charge, but must receive a ticket from the ticket sales booth before they enter.
